    - FCC Chair announced a notice of inquiry as part of FCC's annual evaluation of the broadband access across the country – changing the federal from 25/3 to 100/20 (WA State is already 100/20)
    - ii. Protecting Community Television Act Senate Bill 3361/HR6219
      - 1. This legislation changes one word, related to franchise fees.
    - iii. Net Neutrality and Broadband Justice Act
      - 1. No bill number yet, new bill introduced in July
    - iv. State Broadband Deployment Best Practices Taskforce
    - v. Franchise fee and PEG fee for OTT state legislative effort
      - 1. Oregon has language in law to allow linear foot charges
      - 2. Looking at charges for communications services in the right of way
